Prophecy and Spiritual Genocide

In Thailand many believe in a prophecy that God will increase the numbers of Christians in Thailand from 1% by a great outpouring starting in the North of Thailand. In this Christmas season and a new year fast approaching Christians should not forget that the birth of Jesus was prophesied and did actually happen. "God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?" as stated in Numbers 23:19. Most people would agree to this if they believe in a mighty God. Yet, even Christians that believe in God's prophecy

do not always agree on how prophecy will be revealed. Many people missed the blessing of Jesus' ministry although they believed in the prophecy because they argued over the exact location where the messiah would come from. Even today with prophecy and a vision of God's outpouring in Thailand some are looking only to the Northern area near Chiang Mai. Many forget about the Northeast area like Nong Khai, which could also usher in a great outpouring of God's spirit and considered the next Galilee. After all the Apostle Paul reminds us in Corinthians that none who claims to be a Christian sees the entire truth clearly even with

their best intention. Ironically some Thai Christians and missionaries unknowingly act like certain Pharisees, who tried to hinder Jesus ministry, may in fact be committing Spiritual Genocide in Thailand—preventing people from a life with God. Although not intentionally trying to kill God's prophecy, like Harold tied to do with Jesus. They instead serve where there is good weather and surrounding of a Chiang Mai; and the convenient and popularity of a Bangkok. Although this is needed, often barren area with the most people that do not yet know God like Northeastern Thailand is overlooked. Spiritual Genocide is being committed if we don't catch the vision.
